
### TOULEMONDE BOCHART STORY, FROM OUR COLLECTION TO BESPOKE RUGS


Sustainability and Eco-friendly development are part of the Toulemonde Bochart process :

• Increasing use of recycled and recyclable materials such as recycled Polyester fibres known as PET (for outdoor qualities) or Sarisilk recycled silk.

- Development of a 100% organic collection labelled "Ecocert"
- Development of undyed natural wool

• In terms of logistics and transport as well as in personnel management, our partners are SEDEX certified, a label that guarantees transparency, respect for labour rights and business ethics.

### EXCEPTIONAL KNOW-HOW, BETWEEN TRADITION AND MODERNITY

Our rugs are handmade in India and Nepal according to ancestral know-how, with premium quality raw materials. Our craftsmen are involved in each of the 12 stages of making a rug. They are all master dyers, spinners, weavers, guarantors of unique gestures and techniques, who spin, dye, weave, tuft, knot, wash our rugs to achieve this amazing quality we are pleased to offer.

### **KNOW-HOW**

The process begins with spinning followed by the colourist who adapts the tailor-made dye formula according to the shade, the composition and the type of yarn (1).

This step is crucial to obtain the desired colour while maintaining the luminosity of the dyed material. After the dye bath, the skeins of yarn are hung up to dry (2).

Then comes the skilful work of the weaver who, depending on demand, will weave, tuft or knot the rug. Once made, the carpet is shaved, washed. Once dry, the chasing and finishing are carried out (3).









### **KNOW-HOW**

All the above steps are all done manually by experienced craftsmen. Several quality controls take place throughout the manufacturing process so that the finished product meets our customers' expectations.

In addition to production in the Asia's factories, our bordered carpet finishing workshop in the Paris region offers customization of our floor coverings, with bespoke shapes and finishes (loops, borders, etc.).



# **THE TECHNIQUES**

TOULEMONDE BOCHART RUGS AND FLOOR COVERING CALL ON DIFFERENT TYPES OF MANUAL WEAVING ADAPTED SPECIFICALLY TO EACH PROJECT.

#### HAND-KNOTTED

This is the noblest and most complex technique. The weaver comes to form a knot with the strand around one or more weft threads. The drawing is made point by point following a model carried on a squared paper. The smaller the point, the more precise the drawing (this is the number of nodes).

This technique, most often carried out in our Nepalese workshops, takes time, the work progressing by about 10 cm per day.

INTENDED FOR PROJECTS OF EXCELLENCE, THIS FABRICATION ALLOWS ALL EXTRAVAGANCES OF DRAWING AS WELL AS VIBRANT AND SOPHISTICATED PLAINS.




### **THE TECHNIQUES**

#### HAND-WOVEN

A semi-mechanized process, hand weaving can be done on flat looms (pit loom) or on shuttle looms, a simple version of jacquard looms (looms). Here no knot, but a loop maintained by the tightening of the weft. A glue allows the maintenance of the rug.

# SUITABLE FOR PLAIN CARPETS OR CARPETS WITH SIMPLE PATTERNS (STRIPE, GEOMETRIC...)



### **THE TECHNIQUES**

#### HAND TUFTED


For the tufted rug, the design is printed on a canvas, stretched over a frame. The threads are stitched into this canvas by a gun, either manual or electric, to form the velvet. The backrest is glued with latex to maintain the velvet, then protected by a canvas or mesh.

SUITABLE FOR PATTERNED CARPETS, PLAIN RUGS, SHAPED RUGS.

#### **FINISHES**

For all these techniques, the textures can be looped or cut and the reliefs can be worked at the time of finishing. The velvet can be treated in different heights, patterns can be marked by a sculpture of the velvet, called chasing, either to create a design, or to mark a change of color. These finishes are carried out by experienced and meticulous craftsmen.

#### **INATURAL ANIMAL FIBERS**

#### WOOLS

- · Ability to resist shock or deformation
- · Excellent sound and thermal insulation properties
- Comfortable
- Naturally flame retardant
- Antistatic

Wools are selected from breeds of sheep raised in India, Tibet or New Zealand. All are adapted to the use of the carpet and can be mixed to obtain a perfect yarn.

### **THE MATERIALS**

#### **INATURAL PLANT FIBERS**

#### VISCOSES

art silk - tencel® - bamboo banana fiber

- Touch close to silk
- Natural anti-bacteria
- Weak in water

Those fibres from vegetable cellulose are incredibly shiny. Whether it's bamboo, banana tree, beech wood or eucalyptus for tencel, these materials will capture the light like no other.

#### NATURALS

flax/linen - jute - nettle - hemp - sisa

- Natural and textured appearance
- Environmentally friendly
- Thermoregulator
- Fragile to light

The raw aspect of our materials such as linen, jute and nettle brings an incomparable finish, a deep matte finish and random color variations of great finesse.

#### **SYNTHETIS FIBERS**

#### NYLON

- Glossy or matte
- Good resistance to crushing
- Good resistance to dirt
- Ideal for heavy traffic

#### POLYPROPYLEN

- Solid
- Good humidity resistance
- Ideal for outdoors

#### POLYESTER

- Shiny (more resistant than viscose)
- Ideal for outdoors

#### **RECYCLED PET**

- Matte
- Environmentally friendly
- Ideal for outdoors

Polypropylene and nylon, alone or mixed, and PET will allow outdoor use of your carpet or respond to high traffic areas.

Polyester will meet the demands of rugs with a shiny fiber but more resistant than viscose.



### TREATMENTS

#### **STAIN PROOF TREATMENT**

As a standard Toulemonde Bochart offer rugs are naturally sound absorbent and fire resistant. This treatment allows you to live more serenely by having time to intervene on any stains and avoiding clogging.


They are easily maintained on a regular basis. The rug should be brushed on a regular basis and from time to time vaccumed with either the smooth base or the brush head of vacuum. Be careful of pealing during the first 2 monthes as the rug loses excess wool in fluffs.

#### CAUTION, THE STAIN PROOF TREATMENT MUST BE RENEWED AFTER EACH CLEANING..

#### • COLORS AND MATERIALS


Thanks to a wide choice of natural or synthetic materials and palette colour (pompoms, Pantone, etc.), the studio will submit its proposals to you.

#### MODEL AND SAMPLE

After validating the final design, materials and colors, we can produce a sample (time and size depending on the project), which will allow you to validate the texture and color of the carpet.

#### PRODUCTION

After adjustments and if necessary, validation of the sample, manufacturing will take between 8 to 14 weeks for tufted and woven rugs, and 18 to 20 weeks for knotted. Depending on each project, the deadlines will be specified before the start of production.






